1-DAY (3- 6 HOUR) PROGRAMS

WILLOWS, SANDSTONE AND ELK

Each species has characteristics and behaviors that help it to survive and reproduce. Students will learn about natural selection, adaptation, mutation, and the reason biodiversity ensures health on an ecosystem and global level.

LOCAL WILDLIFE ECOLOGY

Wind Wolves Preserve is the perfect place to study the wildlife of the San Joaquin Valley. Students will learn about local species, their behavior and population fluctuations. Program will include discussions on human impact, restoration projects and wildlife management strategies.
